STUDY AT THE UNIVERSITY is

- the best Russian and international traditions of preparation of high qualified specialists at the internationally oriented University,
- the world known scientists and leading laboratories and schools of sciences for prior science, technic and technology trends,
- opportunity to study at the modern programs designed in cooperation with the leading universities of the world,
- dual academic advising for magister and PhD programs.

The University is listed in Top 500 of Academic Ranking of World Universities and Top 100 of QS-BRICS. Founded in 1960 the University is in Top 5 of the Russian universities ranking.



INSTITUTES, FACULTIES AND STUDENTS

The University has 20 Faculties and Academic Institutes. The teaching staff consists of 2500 lecturers and professors (1500 Ph.D, D.Sc. and academicians). In Moscow campus there are about 20000 students, 6500 of them are international students from more than 150 countries, they are organized in students associations by country and regions.

ACADEMIC YEAR CALENDAR

The academic year is divided in 2 terms of 20 weeks. The first semester starts on September 1st and the second in February; students have vacations of 2 weeks in January and of 6 weeks in July-August.



STUDENTS CAMPUS

PFUR campus, the winner of Moscow Mayor's Trophy «The most comfortable HEI territory», is the absolutely unique place, there is none like that in Russia! The student campus is situated in the south-west of Moscow in one of the best places for study and leisure.

PFUR campus has everything for comfortable life: disposal laundries, dry-cleaning and other ateliers, barber shop and hairdressing saloons, stores and shops, post-office, banks. Special reading-rooms are provided for a better preparation for studies.

The campus nowadays consists of 13 blocks of student hostels housing over 7 000 PFUR students and graduate students. All buildings are very close to each other.

The Hostels are situated in 5-storey, 16-storey and 18-storey buildings offering double and triple rooms, costing from \$980 to \$3500 per year including communal public services cost, water and electricity, furniture, cooking and washing facilities. The rooms have connections to the internet, satellite TV and telephone.

The students are organized in students' councils, in charge of discipline, social education and support of their rights.





MEDICAL CARE

Peoples' friendship university of Russia takes care of students and teachers' health. The multipurpose health facility – University's Medical Centre – is located in the campus to provide high qualified medical assistance. The clinic is up-to-date equipped and staffed with professionals.

All students, academic and administration staff are to pass annual medical survey within the frames of University's program «Students' Health».

University's Medical Centre provides regular health control and care on the basis of medical insurance policy costs of \$ 270 per year.

SECURITY

The site of the University Campus is fenced. The University Security includes guards, round-the-clock CCTV and fire alarm systems. Access to the University buildings is controlled by the electronic gate pass system. Local Police Station and the Department of Internal Security monitor public order and discipline on the campus territory.



SPORTS & LEISURE

To make students' life comfortable at the University, we offer free of charge halls for gymnastics, handball, basketball and football grounds. Tennis courts are also open in the campus.

The University physical health and recreation complex occupies a vast territory of 6500 m2: its bigger part is 4 football courts (2 indoor) and 15 tennis courts. All the year round regardless of the weather students can do sport individually or join any of the 36 sport clubs. One of the University's traditions is organizing annual «Mini World Cups» in different team and individual sports.

There are international post-office, students' international cultural centre, telephone and computer centers, shops in the campus.

After lectures and studies and on days-off students can relax and spend time with friends at numerous cafes and coffee-houses. There are plenty of them: African, Chinese, Arab, Indian, Georgian – they may be found in every hostel block, more than 20 in all.



LANGUAGE

The language of study and communication is Russian. All foreign students pass through the preparatory/foundation course, where during one year they receive accelerated courses of Russian language and the necessary scientific language for their future studies.

So every graduate has opportunity to get the second specialty with a separate diploma of interpreter.

For students in English programmes there are summer language school (more detail information is available on <http://moscowsummerschool.ru>) and vocational courses during academic year.





LIBRARIES

Our Central Library has a literature with about 2,500,000 volumes in many foreign languages as well as specialised libraries at the faculties, institutes, and is of free access to students. At the beginning of the term students receive books at faculty's library and can also freely visit the comfortable reading halls and internet classes whenever they need it.

VISA, TICKET, RESIDENCE PERMIT

Russian students' entry visa will be issued on official invitation to every duly admitted student by Russian diplomatic missions in your country.

International air tickets to fly to Moscow are available from many air companies. Residence permit in Russia will be provided on students' reporting and extended every year. The PFUR International Office will assist our newly admitted students in many countries.

FINANCE

The fees as specified in the Admission Letter are to be paid at the beginning of each academic year (September) to the account of the University.

International bank located in the campus offers private accounts and other services. It's advised to have \$ 300-350 order to meet monthly costs of meals, transport, clothes, private needs, etc.

Tuition fee for studying at the Faculty of Russian language and general disciplines (preparatory/ foundation course) is \$4300, \$4900 - for Medicine and Dentistry.

PFUR-RSS EDUCATIVE-EXHIBITING COMPLEX (EEC)

Founded in cooperation with JSC «Russian Space Systems» with the purposes to design and adoption of global commercializing mechanisms of production and services of the Russian space industry.

EEC has access to the real-time information coming from the RSS Research Centre of the Earth on-line monitoring that gives opportunity to deal with issues in the following spheres:

- Geological Prospecting (mineral exploration);
- Agriculture (detection of crop capacity for different plants, degree of soil aridity, presence of destructive insect);
- Ecology (detection of pollution degree, forestry and water industry monitoring);
- Medicine (medical and biological experiments aboard of the International Space Station, medical preflight cosmonauts' training, researches on influences of long term space flights on human health);
- Transport and Communication (provision of objects' geological positioning and monitoring);
- Fast Response to in Natural Disasters and Emergencies (tsunamis, floods, earthquakes, etc.).





PFUR EDUCATIVE MISSION CONTROL CENTER

Spheres of cooperation:

- **Space Services Promotion**

Spreading the information about services in the sphere of space activities with further negotiation on their acquisition and usage in the interests of private and government organizations with the aim of getting maximum benefit.

- **General Scientific and Educative Direction**

Inviting cosmonauts and considerable scientists as main lecturers for courses of lectures on space activities.

- **Intentional learning**

Deep teaching on usage of a certain service in space activities to benefit within the frame of a specific economic sector.

- **Production of Low Weight and Size Satellites**

This project allows its participants to design and produce low weight and size satellites to carry certain equipment for implementing private business or government purposes, for example in mineral exploration, evaluation of ecological conditions, deforestation and water pollution monitoring.

- **Foundation of Centres of Russian Innovative Technologies**

This sphere gives opportunity to found of centres of Russian innovative technologies or their acquisition from a foreign country.



MOSCOW SUMMER SCHOOL

The School offers 16 courses for Russian and foreign participants: Russian Language, Young Leader School, Regional Characteristics of Russia and its Neighboring States during Globalization, How to make Business in Russia, Russian Hospitality, Russian Women in History, etc.

The School is open in July and August.

Standard two-weeks package costs 900 Euro and consists of:

- study (40 academic hours, 10 days)
- accommodation on the University Campus (14 days)
- two excursions.
